Limitations and Precautions

- Apply only when the temperature is between 5° and 30°.
- Do not apply if rain or a sudden temperature drop is likely to occurduring drying/cure time.
- Do not apply in very hot, dry, or windy conditions.
- Do not apply if the relative humidity is 75% or above.
- Do not add more than 5% thinner.

Surface Preparation

The surface must be dry. Remove all contaminants such as dirt, dust, grease, and any loose particles or flaking paint. For lichen, moss, mould or any other forms of bacterial growth was with APCO Biowash.

Take care to remove chalking, salt deposits and corrosion.

If there are areas of excessive rust or corrosion, then these areas of metal may need to be replaced as painting these may only be a temporary solution.

Application

Stir the contents thoroughly before and during use.

For very porous surfaces, apply thinned 5% with Mineral Turpentine.

Apply by brush, roller or spray.

For spray application: **Nozzle Orifice** 11 -15 thou

Nozzle Pressure 1800 – 2500psi

Fan angle 30 - 50°

For Best Results

- Thorough surface preparation is essential.
- > For very porous surfaces, apply 2 coats. The first coat thinned 5% with Mineral Turpentine.
- ➤ For roofs in coastal/marine areas, apply 2 coats.
- > Over-coat with a minimum of 2 coats of Roofrite Topcoat.
- Adhere strictly to minimum re-coat times for all paint coatings.
- > Use only high quality application equipment.

Storage Store in a cool, well ventilated area. Keep away from direct sources of heat and open flame. Keep the product in correctly labelled containers. Follow correct procedure for the disposal of dried paint material and the packaging.
